

Step 3: Management

Year 1

- Don't expect your pollinator seeding to look great in Year 1. During this time, native wildflowers put most of their energy into root development and will most likely not grow more than a few inches. Some seed sits in the ground for a year before germinating
- Pollinator seed won't germinate until ground temperature is 65 – 70 degrees (mid-June)

Year 2 - 3

- Pollinator establishment should be coming along
- Once pollinator stand is well-established, start management
- Prescribed burning is the BEST management option; talk to PF biologist for advice on burning
- Burn March 15 – April 15 or September 15 – November 15
